CONVENTION INFORMATION

■ **REGISTRATION**: Pre-register online by May 9th Registration fee this year is \$500.00 and includes spouse or guest. Attendees may register online and pay by credit card through PayPal. NOTE: A PayPal account is not required. However, the PayPal site will request an email address and phone number for confirmation purposes.

At the convention, you may visit the registration desk to check in and pick up your ID badge, program, and attendee list. The registration desk will be open from 9am to 6pm on Wednesday, May 25th and 8am to 6pm on Thursday, May 26th. If you have not pre-registered, you may do so at this time.

- VENUE INFORMATION: Situated in the heart of Uptown, The Ritz-Carlton, Dallas provides unparalleled access to the city's most celebrated venues. They are located near the Dallas Cowboys Stadium, as well as the American Airlines Center, home of the Dallas Mavericks and Dallas Stars. REUNION TOWER

The tower is a 561 ft (171 m) observation tower and one of the most recognizable landmarks in Dallas, Texas. Located at 300 Reunion Blvd. in the Reunion district of downtown Dallas, the tower is part of the Hyatt Regency Hotel complex, and is the 15th tallest building in Dallas. Also known locally as "The Orb," it was completed in 1978. At night, the globe at the top of the building is illuminated with 259 custom LED fixtures and are controlled by various computer-generated patterns and colors.


