Prop 65 Summary National Cotton Council October 2018

The U.S. cotton industry has recently been contacted regarding supply chain questions about California's Proposition 65 related to cotton and cotton textile products. Based on existing research, we are not aware of any contaminant materials in raw cotton or cotton yarn that should be considered for a Prop 65 label or other notification.

What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 is a California law that prohibits businesses from knowingly and intentionally exposing any individual to a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm (i.e., a "listed chemical") without first giving clear and reasonable warning to such individual. Under the new rules, the full warning must identify specific chemical(s) and exposure pathway(s). The law applies to all products sold in the State of California, not just products produced in the state. Failure to provide a warning when needed allows private enforcers or state authorities to file legal action.

According to Proposition 65, if a product, in this case textiles containing cotton, has a level of exposure for a listed chemical at or below exposure levels set by the state of California, or by a legal settlement, no warning is required. Past Research and Background Materials

The Bremen Cotton Exchange has conducted numerous tests for possible chemical residues on raw cotton fiber. After samples are collected in various regions by sworn experts or independent collectors, the fiber is tested according to the Oeko-tex® 100 Standard, which includes limits for pesticides and defoliants that may be used during cultivation. Testing has been repeated every few years, and full results for the specimens that were analyzed can be found at https://baumwollboerse.de/en/informationen/untersuchungen/.


