The agenda includes goal-based standards for new ship construction, development of regulations for maritime autonomous ships, safety frameworks for reducing greenhouse gas emissions, updates to maritime



cybersecurity guidelines, measures to enhance maritime security, and efforts addressing piracy, unsafe migration by sea, pollution prevention, and ship design.
