



## Events for the Week of March 2 – March 6, 2026

### Monday, March 2, 2026

- Secretary of State Marco Rubio will travel to Israel to discuss a range of regional priorities, including Iran, Lebanon, and ongoing efforts to implement President Trump’s 20-Point Peace Plan for Gaza.
- Administration officials will give an Iran briefing to congressional leadership.
- The U.S.-China Economic and Security Review Commission will hold a hearing on “Part of Your World: U.S.-China Competition Under the Sea.”

### Tuesday, March 3, 2026

- Federal Reserve Bank of New York President John Williams will deliver keynote remarks at the America’s Credit Union Governmental Affairs Conference 2026 in Washington, D.C.
- Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis President Neel Kashkari will participate in the 2026 Bloomberg Invest conference in New York, NY.
- The House Agriculture Committee will hold a markup of H.R. 7567, the “Farm, Food, and National Security Act of 2026.”
- Director General of the Japan Ministry of Foreign Affairs Latin American and Caribbean Affairs Bureau Motoyuki Ishize will deliver remarks at the Inter-American Dialogue event, “From Production to Consumption: Japan - Latin America Cooperation in Food and Agriculture.”
- Texas, Arkansas, and North Carolina will hold primary elections.

### Wednesday, March 4, 2026

- U.S.-brokered peace talks between Ukraine and Russia are expected to proceed through Thursday, with a potential relocation from Abu Dhabi to Turkey or Switzerland following recent U.S. and Israeli strikes on Iran.
- The Surface Transportation Board will hold a meeting of the Rail Energy Transportation Advisory Committee.
- The House Appropriations Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Subcommittee will hold a hearing on “U.S. Department of Agriculture, Trade and Foreign Agricultural Affairs.”
- The Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee will hold a markup of S. 3923, the “Weather Research and Forecasting Innovation Reauthorization Act of 2026.”
- The National Bank of Poland will announce its interest rate decision.

### Thursday, March 5, 2026

- The Senate Foreign Relations Committee will hold a hearing on the nomination of Frank Garcia to be Assistant Secretary of State for African Affairs.
- The 14<sup>th</sup> National People’s Congress of China will open its fourth annual session.
- Malaysia will announce its interest rate decision.



**Friday, March 6, 2026**

- President of Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco Mary Daly and Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia Governor Anna Paulson will discuss the report “Private Canaries: The Value of Private-Sector Data for U.S. Monetary Policy Making,” and Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland President Beth Hammack will participate in a panel discussion at the 2026 U.S. Monetary Policy Forum in New York, NY.
