



## Events for the Week of March 9 – March 13, 2026

### Monday, March 9, 2026

- President Trump will speak to House Republicans at their policy retreat in Doral, FL. Reports indicate that he will focus on discussing the SAVE America Act and adding restrictions on transgender surgeries and mail voting.
- The State Bank of Pakistan will announce its interest rate decision.

### Tuesday, March 10, 2026

- The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) will hold a meeting to provide updates and insights into ongoing vehicle automation activities across NHTSA.
- At their retreat, House Republicans will hear from White House deputy chief of staff James Blair, 2024 Trump campaign co-manager Chris LaCivita and National Economic Council Director Kevin Hassett. Additionally, House committee chairs will discuss their legislative plans for the year. Of note, House Ways and Means Chair Jason Smith (R-AR) is expected to talk through a list of bipartisan health care and tax priorities, though specific bills are not mentioned.
- The Senate Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry Committee will hold a hearing on “Increasing Domestic Consumption of U.S.-Grown Agricultural Products.” Nathan Reed, chairman of the National Cotton Council, will testify.
- The Senate Foreign Relations Committee will hold a markup to vote on the nomination of William Long to be U.S. ambassador to Iceland and Robert Sweeney to be U.S. director of the Asian Development Bank.
- The Farm Foundation will hold a virtual forum on “Global Productivity, Power Shifts, and the Future of the Global Food System.”
- Malaysia Trade Minister Johari Ghani will hold a video call with Deputy USTR Rick Switzer to discuss the SCOTUS decision and the ART.

### Wednesday, March 11, 2026

- Federal Reserve Vice Chair for Supervision Michelle Bowman will deliver a speech at the American Bankers Association Washington Summit in Washington, D.C.
- Conservative commentator Scott Jennings will brief Republicans on GOP messaging, while podcast host Ben Shapiro will address the “speed of new media” in a Wednesday morning session.
- The Senate Finance Fiscal Responsibility and Economic Growth Subcommittee will hold a hearing on “The Fiscal Outlook: 2027-2036.”

### Thursday, March 12, 2026

- Federal Reserve Vice Chair for Supervision Michelle Bowman will participate in “Basel III and Bank Capital Rules: A Conversation with Vice Chair Michelle Bowman” at The Cato Institute in Washington, D.C.
- The Senate Commerce, Science, and Transportation Committee will hold a markup to vote on the nominations of Michael Graham to be a member of the National Transportation Safety Board and Richard Kloster to be a member of the Surface Transportation Board.



- The Farm Credit Administration will hold a meeting to discuss a report on land values and for a notice of proposed rulemaking - assessment and appointment of administrative expenses.
- South Korea's ruling Democratic Party will hold a vote to pass a special bill to make investments in the U.S. under the trade deal between the countries.
- The Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Central Reserve Bank of Peru will announce its interest rate decision.
