Monday, May 18, 2026

- The Senate will meet to resume consideration of S. Res. 690, authorizing the en bloc consideration in Executive Session of certain nominations on the Executive Calendar. More [here](#).
- The European Central Bank will hold its International Research Forum on Monetary Policy through Tuesday in Frankfurt, Germany.
- The G-7 finance ministers will meet in Paris.

Tuesday, May 19, 2026

- Federal Reserve Governor Christopher Waller will speak at the International Research Forum on Monetary Policy in Frankfurt, Germany.
- Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia Governor Anna Paulson will speak at the ‘2026 Financial Markets Conference: Technology’s Transformative Role in Finance and Central Banking’ in Amelia Island, FL.
- The Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee will hold a markup of reconciliation recommendations to the Budget Committee.
- The Senate Appropriations Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies Subcommittee will hold a hearing on “A Review of the President’s FY2027 Budget Request for the Department of Transportation.”
- Alabama, Georgia, Idaho, Kentucky, Oregon, and Pennsylvania will hold primary congressional elections.
- Japanese Prime Minister Sanae Takichi will visit South Korea.
- The People’s Bank of China will announce its interest rate decision.

Wednesday, May 20, 2026

- The Senate Budget Committee will hold a markup of the reconciliation bill pursuant to S. Con. Res. 33, which sets forth the congressional budget for the U.S. Government for fiscal year 2026 and the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2027 through 2035.
- Bank Indonesia will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Central Bank of Iceland will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Bank of Mauritius will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Central Bank of Nigeria will announce its interest rate decision.

Thursday, May 21, 2026

- The House Appropriations Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies Subcommittee will hold a hearing on “Budget Hearing - Department of Transportation.” Transportation Secretary Duffy will testify.
