Monday, June 8, 2026

- The Senate Agriculture, Nutrition and Forestry Committee will hold a markup to vote on the nomination of Glen Smith to be Agriculture undersecretary for rural development.
- Chinese President Xi Jinping is scheduled to visit North Korea for the first time in seven years.

Tuesday, June 9, 2026

- Maine, North Dakota, Nevada, and South Carolina will hold primary elections.
- The U.S. Chamber of Commerce will hold its Capital Markets Summit, in Washington, D.C. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Commissioner Hester Peirce, director of the SEC's Division of Corporate Finance Jim Maloney, and House Financial Services Chairman French Hill (R-AR) will deliver remarks. - The House Foreign Affairs Committee will hold a markup of H.R. 9086, to amend the Foreign Service Act of 1980 to modify and improve that Act; H.R. 9062, to increase the capacity and effectiveness of the Department in supporting American businesses operating overseas and protecting American industries from adversaries; and H.R. 9087 to direct the Secretary of State to take actions with respect to certain foreign affairs matters.
- The Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Surface Transportation, Freight, Pipelines, and Safety Subcommittee will hold a hearing on “The Need for Speed: How Technological Advances are Driving Transportation Innovation.” President and CEO of the American Trucking Associations Chris Spear and President and CEO of the Association of American Railroads Ian Jefferies will testify.
- The European Council will meet through Wednesday in Brussels, Belgium to discuss the EU's digital, telecommunications, and cybersecurity policies.
- The Central Bank of Kenya will announce its interest rate decision.

Wednesday, June 10, 2026

- The USDA-AMS Cotton and Tobacco Program will hold its 2026 Upland Matching Review in Memphis, TN.
- The House Agriculture Committee will hold a hearing on “Agricultural Perspectives on the Future of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement.”
- The Senate Agriculture, Nutrition and Forestry Committee will hold a hearing on “Oversight of the U.S. Department of Agriculture.” Agriculture Secretary Brooke Rollins will testify.
- The Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee will hold a hearing on “Oversight of the Colorado River Basin, including Post-2026 Operations Negotiations.” Deputy commissioner of operations in the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation David Palumbo and Assistant Interior Secretary for Water and Science Andrea Travnicek will testify.
- The Arizona Cotton Growers & Ginners Annual Meeting will be held through Thursday in Flagstaff, AZ.



- The Bank of Canada will announce its interest rate decision.

Thursday, June 11, 2026

- The Senate Armed Services Committee will hold a closed markup of the National Defense Authorization Act for FY2027.
- Farm Credit Administration will hold a meeting for a quarterly report on economic conditions and Farm Credit System condition and performance and a semiannual report on Office of Examination operations.
- The Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey will announce its interest rate decision.
- The European Central Bank will announce its interest rate decision and is likely to raise rates a quarter point.
- The Central Reserve Bank of Peru will announce its interest rate decision.
- The 2026 FIFA World Cup will begin in Mexico City, Mexico.

Friday, June 12, 2026

- Export-Import Bank (EXIM) will hold a virtual meeting of the 2026-2027 EXIM Advisory Committees for discussion of EXIM policies and programs designed to support the expansion of financing support for U.S. manufactured goods and services.
