Monday, June 15, 2026

- President Trump will attend the 52nd G7 leaders' summit being held through Wednesday in Évian-les-Bains, France.
- The Health and Human Services Department and National Institutes of Health will hold a virtual meeting of the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences. The agenda includes a discussion related to microplastics. Details [here](#).
- The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will hold a virtual meeting of the Science Advisory Board Contaminant Candidate List 6 Augmented Drinking Water Committee. The agenda includes a briefing from the EPA and a review of the draft contaminant candidate list.

Tuesday, June 16, 2026

- The Federal Open Market Committee will begin its two-day closed meeting to discuss monetary policy and set interest rates.
- Oklahoma will hold its primary election, Alabama and Georgia will hold primary runoffs, and California will hold a special primary election for the U.S. House.
- The Bank of Namibia will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Reserve Bank of Australia will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Bank of Japan will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Central Bank of Chile will announce its interest rate decision.

Wednesday, June 17, 2026

- Federal Reserve Board Chairman Kevin Warsh will hold a news conference following a Federal Open Market Committee meeting, where he will announce its interest rate decision.
- The U.S. Chamber of Commerce will hold its 2026 Environmental Innovation Summit in Washington, D.C. Tim Petty, assistant Commerce secretary for oceans and atmosphere and deputy NOAA administrator; Dustin Sherer, deputy assistant Interior secretary for water and science organization; and Aubrey Bettencourt, former chief of the Agriculture Department's Natural Resources Conservation Service, will participate in a discussion on "Water Policy Transformation."
- The Senate Foreign Relations Committee will hold a markup of several measures. Details [here](#).
- Riksbank will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Central Bank of Brazil will announce its interest rate decision.

Thursday, June 18, 2026

- The Energy Department will hold a joint virtual meeting of the International Energy Agency's (IEA) Industry Advisory Board, the IEA's Standing Group on Emergency Questions, and the IEA's Standing Group on the Oil Market.
- The Business Council for International Understanding will hold a discussion in Washington, D.C. on new developments in U.S. trade and investment policies, U.S. commercial diplomacy



initiatives, and opportunities for U.S. exporters. Commerce undersecretary for international trade in the International Trade Administration, William Kimmitt, will speak.

- The Central Bank of the Philippines will announce its interest rate decision.
- Bank Indonesia will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Bank of Botswana will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Swiss National Bank will announce its interest rate decision.
- Norges Bank will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Czech National Bank will announce its interest rate decision.
- The National Bank of Ukraine will announce its interest rate decision.
- The Bank of England will announce its interest rate decision and is expected to hold rates steady.

Friday, June 19, 2026

- ACSA's office will be closed in observance of Juneteenth.
- U.S. government offices and trading markets will be closed in observance of Juneteenth.
- The U.S.-Iran peace deal will be signed in Switzerland.
- The Central Bank of Russia will announce its interest rate decision.
