



## Events for the Week of June 29 – July 3, 2026

### Monday, June 29, 2026

- The Supreme Court is expected to issue final decisions of its term, including on whether President Trump can remove Federal Reserve Governor Lisa Cook.
- Freedom 250 will hold the Great American State Fair, with the theme “Everyday Health and Well Being,” on the National Mall in Washington, D.C.
- The Environmental Protection Agency will hold virtual meetings of the Science Advisory Board Contaminant Candidate List 6 Augmented Drinking Water Committee through Thursday.
- The European Central Bank will hold its Forum on Central Banking through Thursday in Sintra, Portugal.
- The 2026 Wimbledon Championship tennis tournament will begin in London, England.

### Tuesday, June 30, 2026

- The State Department will hold a virtual meeting to prepare for the International Maritime Organization’s 137<sup>th</sup> session of the council with reports on the Enhancement of the Global Integrated Shipping Information System; the Maritime Safety Committee, and the Protection of vital shipping lanes. - The House Foreign Affairs Committee will hold a markup of H.R. 9062, to increase the capacity and effectiveness of the Department of State in supporting American businesses operating overseas and protecting American industries from adversaries; H.R. 9087, to direct the Secretary of State to take actions with respect to certain foreign affairs matters; and H.R. 1939, to require the imposition of sanctions with respect to conflict in Sudan.
- The Bank of the Republic of Colombia will announce its interest rate decision and will likely raise rates.

### Wednesday, July 1, 2026

- The formal review process of the U.S.-Mexico-Canada trade treaty will begin.
- Federal Reserve Board Chairman Kevin Warsh will speak at the European Central Bank Forum on Central Banking in Sintra, Portugal.
- The House Financial Services Committee will hold a markup of a Resolution to Reauthorize the Task Force on Monetary Policy, Treasury Market Resilience, and Economic Prosperity.
- The U.S. men’s soccer team will play against Bosnia-Herzegovina in its first knockout-stage game of the World Cup.

### Friday, July 3, 2026

- ACSA’s office will be closed in observance of Independence Day.
- U.S. trading markets will be closed in observance of Independence Day.
- President Donald Trump will deliver remarks at a Freedom 250 event at the Mount Rushmore National Memorial in Keystone, SD.
