



Events for the Week of August 31 – September 4, 2026

Monday, August 31, 2026

- The Department of Energy will hold a virtual meeting of the National Petroleum Council.
- The Environmental Protection Agency will likely announce its decision on the backlog of pending Small Refinery Exemptions (SRE) under the Renewable Fuel Standard.
- G20 finance ministers and central bank governors will meet in Ashville, North Carolina.
- The Shanghai Cooperation Organization will hold its annual summit in Kyrgyzstan.

Tuesday, September 1, 2026

- President Trump will meet with U.S. refiners and fuel retailers to discuss efforts to lower gasoline prices.
- Federal Reserve Vice Chair for Supervision Michael Barr will deliver remarks.
- Massachusetts will hold its primary elections.
- The Reserve Bank of New Zealand will announce its interest rate decision.

Wednesday, September 2, 2026

- The House Ways and Means Committee will hold a hearing on “Strategic Partnerships to Secure Critical Resources and Supply Chains.”
- The House Financial Services Committee will hold a hearing on “Strengthening the American Economy: Promoting Growth, Opportunity, and Prosperity.” Witnesses include Macy Martin, president of the New York Stock Exchange and Heath Tarbert, former CFTC chairman.
- The Federal Reserve will release its Beige Book.
- UK leader Andy Burnham will deliver his first Prime Minister’s Questions in parliament.
- The Bank of Canada will announce its interest rate decision.
- German Bundesbank President Joachim Nagel will deliver remarks.

Thursday, September 3, 2026

- Federal Reserve Governor Christopher Waller will deliver remarks.
- Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland President Beth Hammack will deliver remarks.
